

About the Route

- Productivity ranks 10 of 18 in passengers per revenue hour
- One-way figure-eight loop isn't convenient for passengers
- Duplicates service provided by the Modesto Junior College Pirate Express, which runs between the Western and Eastern campuses
- Sunday on-time performance is worse than on weekdays and Saturdays
- Ridership is relatively consistent between 7:00 am and 3:00 pm
- Routes 26, 33, and 36 provide duplicative service on Carpenter Road
- Very minimal daily usage from either college campus

Opportunities

- Provide bi-directional service to eliminate long one-way loop
- Adjust alignment to avoid duplication with MJC Pirate Express service
- Restructure routes 26, 33, and 36 to reduce duplication.
- Partner with MJC to provide service Fridays, between fall and spring semesters

Proposed Changes

- Where it goes: Route would connect Modesto Junior College West Campus and the neighborhood directly to the Modesto Transit Center, with travel in both directions except for the loop near the college. Service along California Avenue would be served in both directions by Route 26
- When it runs: No change
- How often it runs: Run every 30 min until 8pm
- Other changes: Improve reliability
